May Meeting Minutes _____

- The May meeting was a joint meeting with the Indoor Gardening Society and was held at MWCSS club member Laura Noble's house. Thank you, Laura, for your hospitality and the program of the month, which was a video of the Sonoran Desert that she purchased at the Desert Museum in Tucson, AZ.
- The treasurer's report, as well as the show and sale financial report, was discussed.
- There was discussion on the 2016 show and sale, which was held in March. Issues regarding the large crowd were mentioned. It was decided that a show committee needs formed to reorganize/improve items for next year.
- The June meeting/field trip to Stan Hywet Hall and Gardens in Akron was discussed/finalized. Please see details above in the "June Meeting/Field Trip" section.
- Regarding The Holden Arboretum plant sale that was held in May, this was done for club exposure, not for profit. The Holden Arboretum fee was 20 percent of sales. The setup area was small but manageable, in a low-traffic area in the craft building. Bill Hendricks, MWCSS club president, sold about 2/3 of his plants. The staff at Holden was extremely helpful.
- The Christmas holiday meeting will be held Dec. 11. Club members voted to have it at Henn Mansion in Eastlake. Club member Beverly Dahms has a personal contact there. The rental fee is \$300 plus a \$100 deposit; so \$400 will be paid at booking. Club members are asked to bring a pot luck dish, and the club will purchase the main course (spiral ham).
- The possibility of holding a club meeting at The Holden Arboretum next year was discussed. Bill Hendricks will speak to Holden workers on this.
- Club members expressed much interest in using club money to attend the Cactus and Succulent Society of America (CSSA) convention in Tempe, AZ. The convention runs from July 26-31, 2017 (next year). Further discussion will be held in the upcoming months.
