- All of the Trees will be Fraser Firs and in a predetermined location. They are 6', 8' & 10' tall; your tree's height is determined by it's location and is listed to the right along with the clubs that have signed up so-far.
- You only need decorations; warm white LED lights will be placed on all trees before we decorate
- **DO NOT** plan OR place any decorations at base of trees as there are plans already to put plant material/blooming plants
- Please bring step ladders and any other items you may need that will assist you in decorating your tree
- We will be validating parking during decorating.
